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CLEANING & MAINTENANCE OF PAP & PAP SUPPLIES

Your Positive Airway Pressure device does not require regular servicing. It is classified as Durable Medical Equipment, meaning that they are built to last! To increase the life of your machine and to ensure that it operates as it should, follow the simple guidelines below:

FILTERS: Change them regularly. Most PAP devices come with 2 filters.

One is ultra-fine (Airsense/Dreamstation) and one is regular (older models). Usually one is disposable and will need to be replaced while the other is reusable and will require cleaning. Consult your device manual for proper maintenance.

for proper maintenance

TUBING: The tubing is used to carry the air from the PAP device to the interface. You should inspect and clean the

tubing once a week.

Check the tubing to make sure that it is clean, pliable and free of holes or tears. Clean the tubing once a

week with warm, soapy water and then rinse thoroughly. Allow to air dry.

Once per month, clean the tubing in 1 part white vinegar to 4 parts water. This will completely disinfect the tubing and prevent any bacteria from growing. If you think that your tubing needs to be replaced, call

the DME Company.

INTERFACES: The interface is used to deliver the air pressure to your face. Inspect it weekly for wear and tear. Most

interfaces will last a long time if cared for properly. Clean your interface daily in warm, soapy water and then rinse thoroughly. Allow to air dry. Once a week, clean the interface with 1 part white vinegar to 4

parts water.

This will completely disinfect the interface and prevent any bacteria from growing. If replacement is

needed, contact the DME Company to get a replacement.

CHINSTRAPS: Chin Straps should be washed once a week in warm, soapy water and allowed to air dry. Never place a

chin strap in a washer and dryer.

HUMIDIFIERS: There are 2 types of humidifiers, Passover and Heated. Humidifiers can help to make the air more

comfortable to breathe. You should <u>ONLY USE DISTILLED OR BOTTLED WATER IN THE HUMIDIFIER</u>. Regular tap water can clog it with minerals and sediment. The water chamber should be cleaned with warm, soapy water every day. Once a week you should disinfect it with 1 part white vinegar and 4 parts water. This will completely disinfect the interface and prevent any bacteria from growing. Inspect the

chamber weekly for any cracks that could cause a water leak.

Periodically, the chamber will need to be replaced. Contact the DME Company to obtain a replacement

water chamber.
